FROM THE WEST: via I-20 or from the North via I-35W: I-35W south to Exit 17 the 2258 Rd Exit. Cross back over I-35W after exiting then from stop sign proceed approx. 4.7 miles east to County Road 206, turn right or south on 206. Continue 1.1 miles to trailer parking on left or 1.3 miles to sale site.

FROM HILLSBORO/1-35W: Take Exit 15 the Grandview/ Maypearl 916 Rd exit. Turn right on 916 and continue approx. 4.8 miles to County Road 206. Turn left/north on to 206 go 1.5 miles to stop sign, then turn back left/north continue 0.4 miles to sale site or 0.6 miles to trailer parking.

Her show career may have been limited but we know that the possibilities have zero limits in regard to the future of this young donor dam. Annie K 214C, the maternal granddam of Lot 3, has proven herself to be the kind to produce productive females with phenotype and herdsire prospects alike. One of her natural bull calves would work for Walrod Cattle Company and at Shipwreck as well. Game Day is a son of KCC1 Exclusive that offers a dense, stout package of body, shape, and bone with an athletic build and look. Both the yearling bull pen and the replacement female pen includes cattle from the second-generation matriarch and more on the way. The Annie K family is strong and dense in real world merit and phenotype, and they are the definite kind to build around.

This loudly marked red head by the Triple Crown winning sire, Broker, blends two of the most productive cow families that we have owned. If it wasn't for the extra white, we are confident that she would be one of the dominant highlights of the fall born sale offering in the country. However, looking past that, we believe that there is tremendous upside from several angles. She is marked as such that she will never be missed or looked over, her skeleton and angles are near textbook, she is flawless in motion, size and kind are not in question, and she exhibits enough body density, shape, and true width to be quality enough at any level.

In production we think she becomes more valuable when mated to Red Angus studs to produce those popular percentage reds and has the credentials to make the next great red baldy herd sire for the Simmental breed. Her red is right, and her white is as bright as her future.
