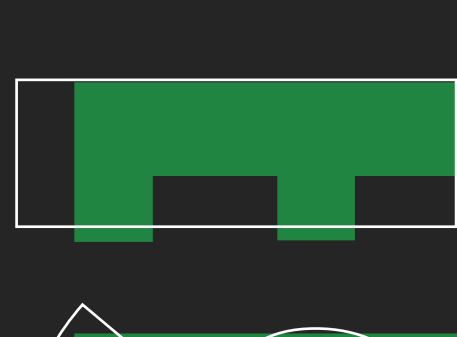
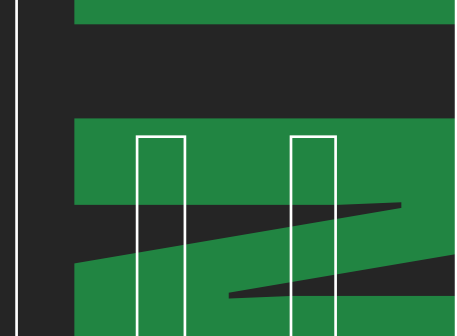
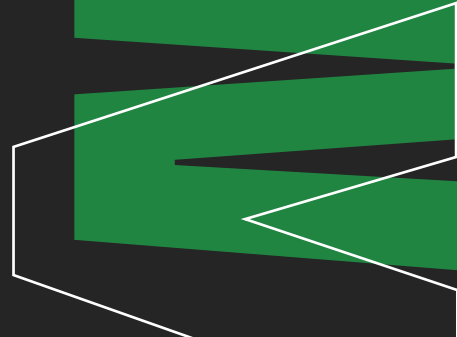

Belle was named the Reserve Supreme Champion Heifer at the Iowa Beef Expo. The LOT 1 daughter of PVF The Natural is on another level when describing her look from the side. LOT 2 is a full sib to Sloane's heifer. She has the same balance and power but sets down on a softer and squarer hind leg.
