

Not only is she the lead off female in this event, but she leads a very potent set of sisters and cow family members that represent the Ford RJ Dolly Y83 cow family. The STCC Tecumseh 058J cattle are very popular across the land as he has stamped his progeny with plenty of look, power, and substance. This elegant female is from the KCC1 Estelle 510E donor dam that produced the highest averaging set of full and maternal brothers in the 2023 edition of the Kearns Cattle Company bull sale. In her youth KCC1 Estelle was exhibited by Brecken Shipman. She claimed Reserve Calf honors at the 2018 Fort Worth Stock Show and Rodeo and went on to break into the top 20 at the 2018 AJSA National Classic. We believe in the future of this female and are certain she will have only fans come October 21, 2023. She is beautifully constructed with a near ideal front third, an explosive center body, a big back, wide and square pin set, and a very, very nice set of running gear.

Jerry Adamson and Chris Ford when on to mate her to WAGR Driver 706T to make Y83. FORD RJ Dolly Y83 was selected by Tom Kearns from the Nebraska Cattleman's Classic as a bred female carrying the next generation donor for Zach Kearns, TKCC Victoria 57A is the dam of KCC1 Estelle 510E and KCC1 Havana 83E, both have become very potent for Zach and his family over the past few years and will be cornerstones for his program for years to come. This blaze faced centerfold will definitely carry on the tradition of production and power just as those before her have done. She has the undeniable futuristic look to get you to the backdrop and then the donor pen.

When this female arrived in Grandview, I thought I was experiencing dejavu. This female reminds me so much of her big sister the 2020 Black Label high selling sale feature, KCC1 SWC Harmony 847H. 847H was selected and campaigned by Megan Brown with much success. Besides her tan bark achievements, her production achievements are definitely worth noting as she has become a significant generator. Her first ET son 3BCC KCC1 Krypton 100K commanded a \$450,000 hammer price in the 2023 Hartman Cattle Company Bull Sale, and her first ET heifer calf commanded \$38,000 in the 2022 edition of the Black Label as well. So, to say that Lot 5 reminds me as an exact replica of her ES Right Time FA110-4 sired older sister should be taken as a compliment in high regard. SO Remedy 7F tends to leave his progeny looser spined and hinged and that is one area she impresses us over her older sister. However, she does maintain the same bone substance, width, dimension, upper rib shape, shear power and flexibility that KCC1SWC Harmony 847H was acclaimed for. SWC KCC1 Lovanna 383L will write her own page for her cow family history and carry on the tradition of quality and generating ability as set forth by those that precede her and those that will follow her. This cow family is the ticket for all things beef production without question.

I reached out to Bill two or three years ago about some of his newer sires that he was using and after telling him what I would like to accomplish, he never hesitated to suggest BC Robust 0807. On my way to another sale, I stopped in to look through the first offering that the Collum Family offered at public auction and the first pasture we went into was a set of bred heifers running with a herd bull and I remember telling myself that I hoped that herd bull was Robust. As it turned out it was 0807 as he looked like everything Bill described him as only better. The purpose of the SimAngus is to take two of the best from both breeds and make one that is better. I would say mission accomplished in Lot 6. I get it that she may not be as tricked out as the trademark freak shows that get backdrop status immediately, but I strongly believe that patience and time are going to be extremely kind to this May born female as she grows and matures. Her dam is phenomenal in my most



biased opinion and she comes from a flush with brothers that will be highlights the first Thursday of March in the 2024 Kearns Cattle Company Bull Sale. She too has sisters that make people take second looks and one that is generating each marketing opportunity that her progeny enters. This gem is a maternal sister to the \$240,000 KCC1 Countertime 872H that is experiencing more and more use with each breeding season. Quite a story, quite a resume.







A full sister to her maternal granddam, DAF Reba C707, followed in her sister's footsteps the following year when she was slapped Grand Champion Percentage Simmental Heifer at the 2017 National Western Stock Show.
