He is long sided, cool necked and has the big flexible running gear that will allow him to have a long and comfortable breeding tenure. The added eye appeal and soundness of build allowed for 844 to make plenty of friends in the yards of Denver this year. But don't take his good looks as the only point of conversation on this leadoff Prolific son.

• His genomic tabulations suit the trends that the "Business Breed" is set for! Not only is his combination of growth impressive, but he sports an elitist top 1% \$M, an index that predicts profitability of a sire in a program where replacement females that are retained in herd and the remainder of the cull females and all male progeny are sold as feeder cattle. Additionally he ranks top 1% for Claw and top 2% for Angle, a pair of traits that are becoming necessary to pay serious attention to.

• His dam, CN DJ Annie Oakley 565 has been a strong force in the breeding pasture for approaching a decade now. She defines what the role model female in production should be, highly productive, fertile, built for longevity and profitable. She has raised maternal brothers to lot 13 that include the Chestnut Regiment 702 bull that in the 2023 Bull Sale to Robert Ford.
